For the enjoyment and safety of all skate participants, please respect the following guidelines. Bethany Christian Reformed Church reserves the right to refuse service to anyone found in violation of these guidelines.

General

- This is a shared-use facility for public enjoyment
- The ice surface is being maintained by volunteers, if there are any concerns please text Steve: 905-658-6051 or Dan: 289-969-6961
- Please respect other skaters and this facility
- Profanity, abusive language & aggressive behavior is not permitted

Safety

- In case of emergency, call 911
- Do not use the ice when ice surface is unsafe or melting
- CSA-approved helmets are strongly recommended
- Recommended 30 skaters maximum on the ice at one time

Not Permitted on Ice Surface

- Food and drinks
- Animals
- Speed skates
- Smoking/vaping/alcohol consumption on property
- Body contact or checking

Assumption of Risk

- Use this rink at your own risk
- Skaters and spectators are deemed to have knowledge of and assume the inherent risks involved with ice skating; these include, but are not limited to:
 - Injuries from collisions or contact with other individuals on the ice surface
 - Injuries from falls
 - Injuries from pucks, sticks and other hockey equipment that may cause injury during routine activities connect to the sport
